Israeli “pinkwashing”
promotes LGBT tourism
to divert attention from
human rights crimes
against Palestinians.

Five reasons not to fall
for it:

Military occupation of the West Bank, East Jerusalem and Gaza since 1967. Over 220 illegal Israeli settlements are built on stolen Palestinian land.

Violence against Palestinian children

Israeli troops arrest hundreds each year, mostly for throwing stones, and hold them in military detention, with no access to lawyers.

The inhuman siege on Gaza blocks import of food, fuel and medical supplies. Israel killed over 2,000 people, including more than 500 children, when it attacked Gaza in 2014. The siege means rebuilding homes, schools and hospitals is impossible. Water and electricity supplies are still disrupted.

The ethnic cleansing of Palestinians from their homes and land, starting in 1948 and continuing today, creating millions of refugees.

The apartheid system of roads reserved for Jewish Israelis, the 8-metre apartheid wall and daily Palestinian humiliation at hundreds of checkpoints.

Palestinians are calling on people worldwide to boycott Israel until it recognises the Palestinians' right to self-determination and complies with international law.

Just Don't Go

Boycott Israel until they:

- End the occupation, dismantle the Wall and lift the siege on Gaza
- Recognise the right of return of Palestinian refugees
- Give full equality for Palestinians who live inside Israel
